

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.150000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Ector County Hospital District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.150000 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.125343 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.284196 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Ector County Hospital District from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Ector County Hospital District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Ector County Hospital District is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2026 AT 8:30AM AT MEDICAL CENTER HOSPITAL BOARD ROOM.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Ector County Hospital District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Ector County Hospital District at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Ector County Hospital District last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Ector County Hospital District this year.

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures

The Ector County Hospital District spent \$28,936,953 from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026 on indigent health care compensation expenditures at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$27,132,522.00. This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by \$0.115428/\$100.
