A. Finance Committee

1. Financial report for month ended November 30, 2019

- 2. Capital Expenditure Requests
 - a. Consider Approval of Alaris IV Pumps

Christin Timmons presented the Capital Expenditure Request (CER) for the purchase of 440 Alaris IV pumps. The current pumps are end-of-life and can no longer be repaired if inoperable. This number is comparable to the average daily census for the facility, allowing for LTACH, increased NICU volume and critical patients who need more than one pump.

David Dunn moved and Wallace Dunn seconded the motion to approve the CER Alaris IV Pumps as presented. The motion carried unanimously.
